

CAF Spring Meeting at the field. 12 April 2:00 PM

17 members present, 58 degrees. Very windy.

The meeting was held in an open discussion format

- Andy recapped things accomplished from the fall meeting. Fall minutes presented as email were approved.
- Chuck had to leave so Andy presented the financial statement which was approved.
- Spring field maintenance was discussed. **We will have a workday the 25th, Saturday at nine**, to roll the field (parallel to the flight line and rolled three times), do some pavilion mulching and paint the cable yellow (thank you Herb). Come and help if you can. Craig will supervise. Jim said he would help. *Guys please come out and help. Running the roller is fun.* Things to be completed are:
 - Roll the field, three times. From the flight line, forward.
 - Pull grass/weeds from under the pavilion.
 - Spread more mulch under the pavilion. 3 bags are in the shed.
 - install PVC sleeves in the field for tail anchors.
- Weed and feed (\$300) was and will be applied.
- No new white stones need to be applied.
- Joe announced a fun fly for helicopters June 27th. **No fixed wing flying between 8 and 5 that day.** Jeff Black, Regional three district rep from Hanover will be there. Tony and Anthony are running the show and they will be requesting help to register pilots and park cars. Food will be served by his wife and Anthony's wife. Donations will be requested. They hope to have a vendor present to do a flying demo and there may be a full size helicopter there as well. Ads will be on social media. An official pilots meeting to explain our boundaries will be held at 9.
- Joe announced the 5th annual Swap Meet for September 5th.
