The meeting was held in an open discussion format

- Andy called the meeting to order mentioning that all to do from the fall meeting were accomplished except his which was to put in ground stake holders. There was no complaint.
- The minutes were accepted as presented.
- Chuck presented the financial statement pointing out significant items on the report of which all attendees had a copy. They were accepted.

- Andy will arrange mowers repair with Man and Machine guessing the cost to be about \$325. There was no objection to the cost.
- Fall is when we elect officers for the coming year. Proposed are last years with the exception of the VP. Thanks to Richard for filling that spot for the last few years. The following were elected: Prez, Andy; VP, Jim Murdock; Treasure, Chuck; Secretary, Robey. Appointed offices are Safety, Al; and Event Chairman, Joe.
- Jim Murdock has been footing the bill for the website (thank you Jim). A motion that the club should be paying for it was made and approved.
- Joe also talked about the Christmas party. It will be held 13 December at Brothers on Old Gettysburg Pike. Individuals can order off the menu and it is BYOB. The non mandatory gift exchange will be held - max gift \$25. Joe also mentioned we should be thinking about who deserves the Crash Award. He also thanked all that helped with the very successful Swap Meet and we plan to do it again next year,
- Only new business brought up was paying for crab grass abatement and any reasonable cost was approved. See above .
